I am pleased to announce that the City of Canada Bay will soon begin work on the Cintra Park Netball Amenities Upgrade. This project will help deliver a fit for purpose amenities building to support the growth of netball in our area and provide upgraded facilities for our local community to enjoy.

Cintra Park is a well-established netball facility in our area. Inner Western Suburbs Netball Association (IWSNA) have been using the courts since 1966. The IWSNA has over 3,600 members and has been experiencing year on year growth of approximately 5%.

Project plans include extending the existing building, incorporating the following key features:

- New canteen
- Outdoor covered barbecue space
- · Covered spectator areas
- Re-purposed internal meeting room, office and administration spaces
- Change rooms
- Medical room
- · Store rooms
- · Showering facilities.

The \$1.6 million project is jointly funded by the City of Canada Bay (\$0.4 million) and the Federal Government (\$1.2 million) as part of the Community Development Grants (CDG) programme.

Construction is scheduled to commence in early September 2019 with the facilities to be reopened in April 2020.
