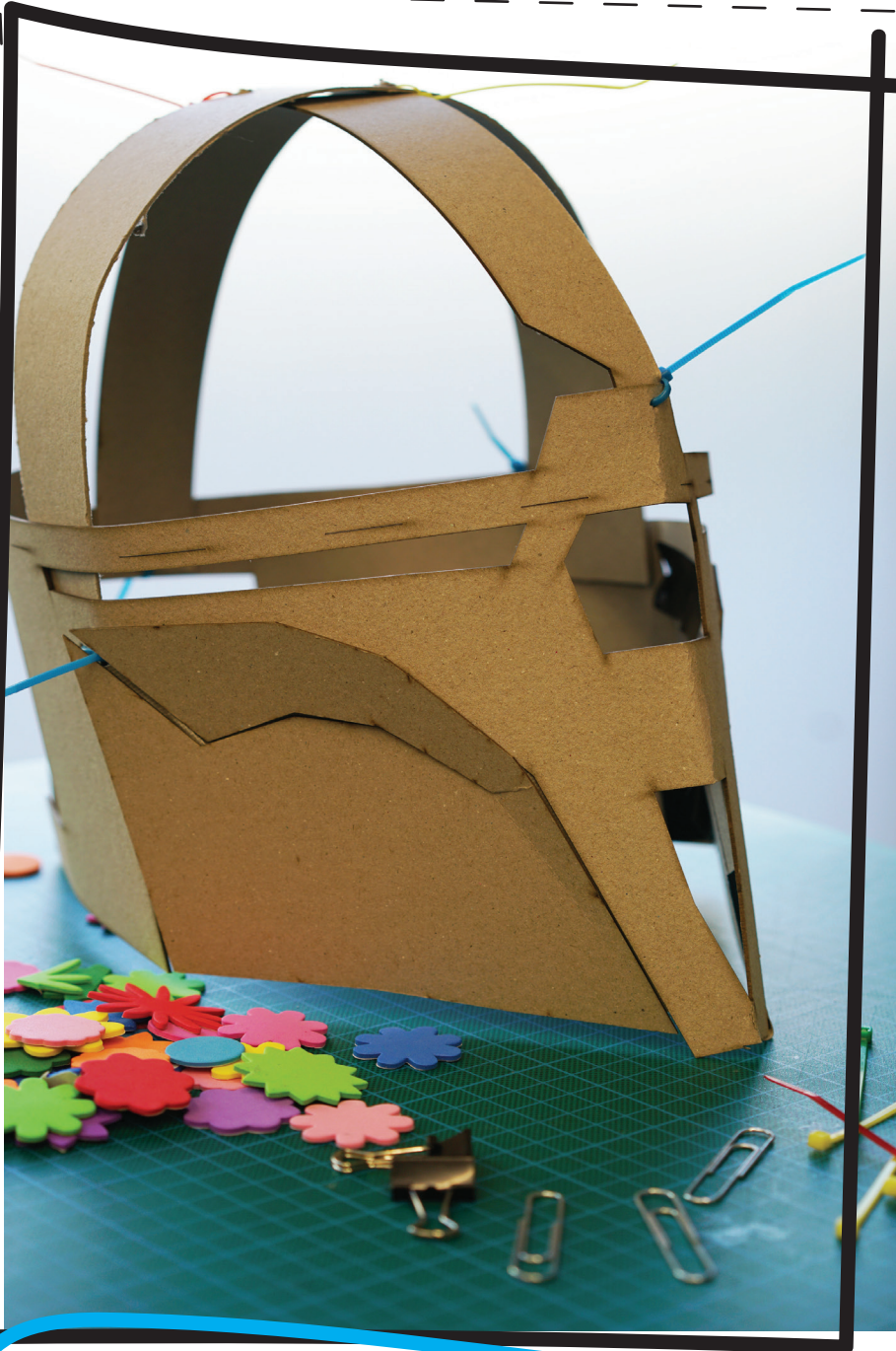

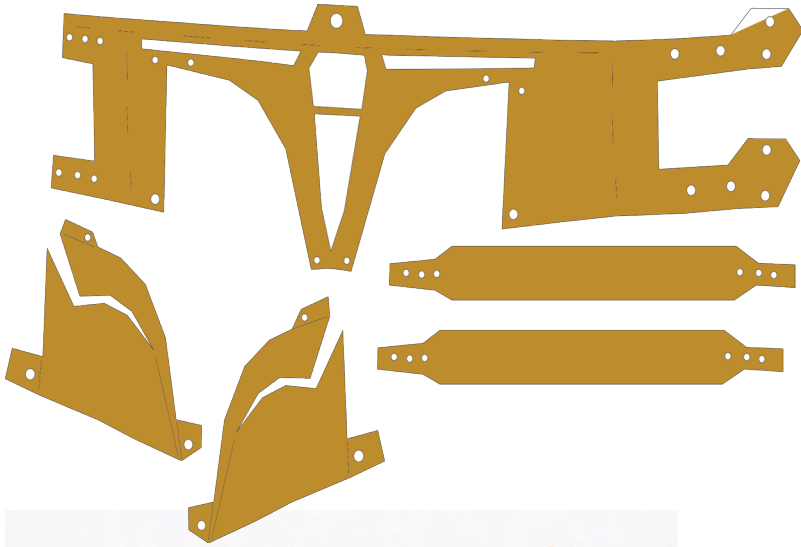
Warning:

BOUNTY HUNTER HELMET

Let's make and remix a helmet inspired by 'The Mandalorian' !

To make a helmet, you need:



Cardboard helmet template, cut out.



Mini cable-ties



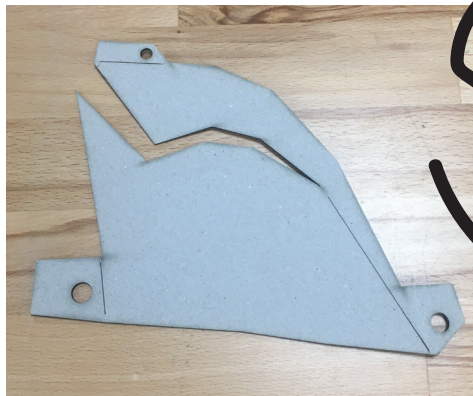
Masking tape (optional)



To decorate, use your favourite craft supplies!

ASSEMBLY

STEP 1.



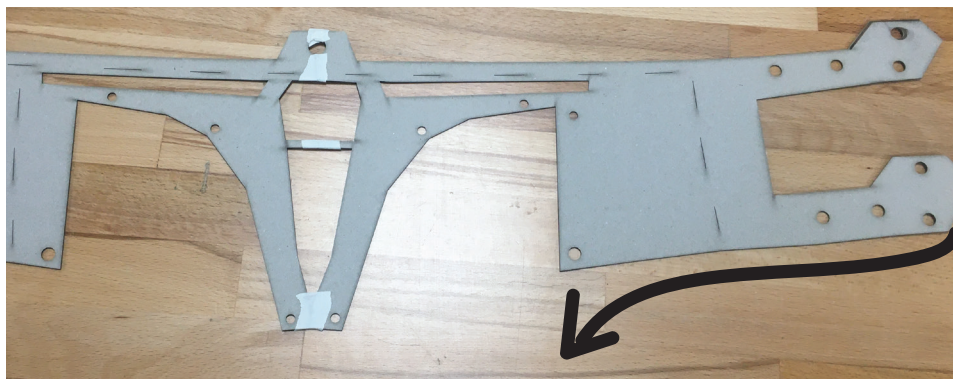
Take one of the cheekplates, fold up along line and tape on back



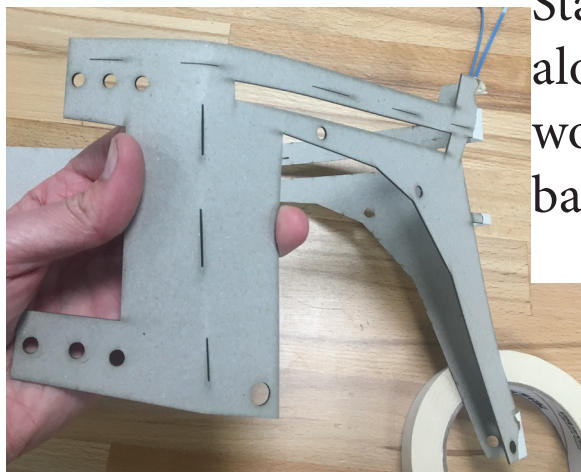
Repeat for both sides

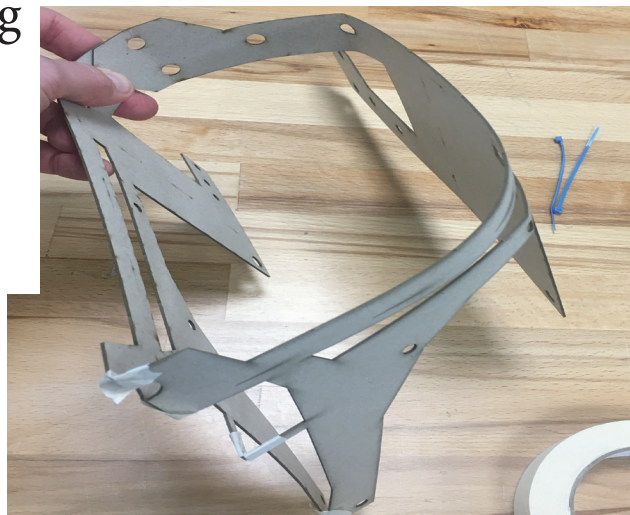
STEP 2.



Take headpiece and start to roll into circle



Start by bending along cut lines, working from back to front

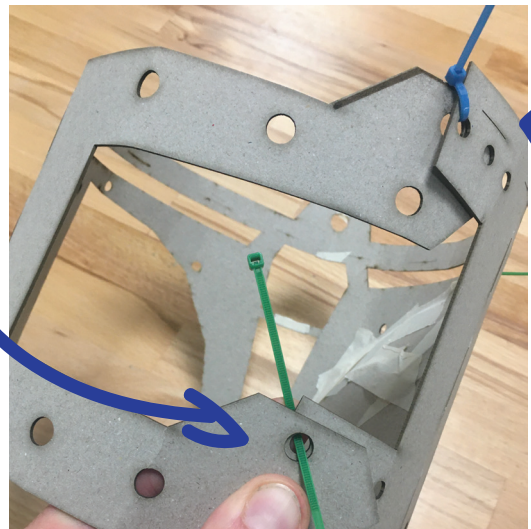


STEP 3.

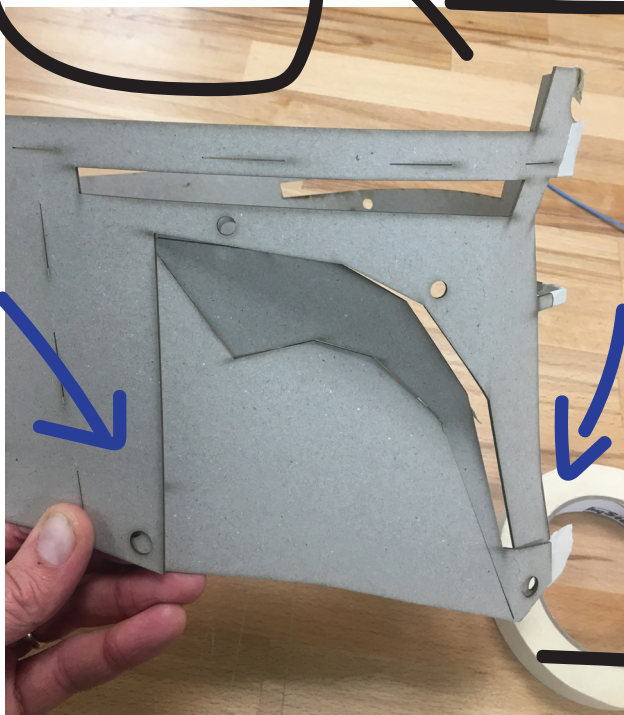


Roll the faceplate into a circle so it can fit over your head.

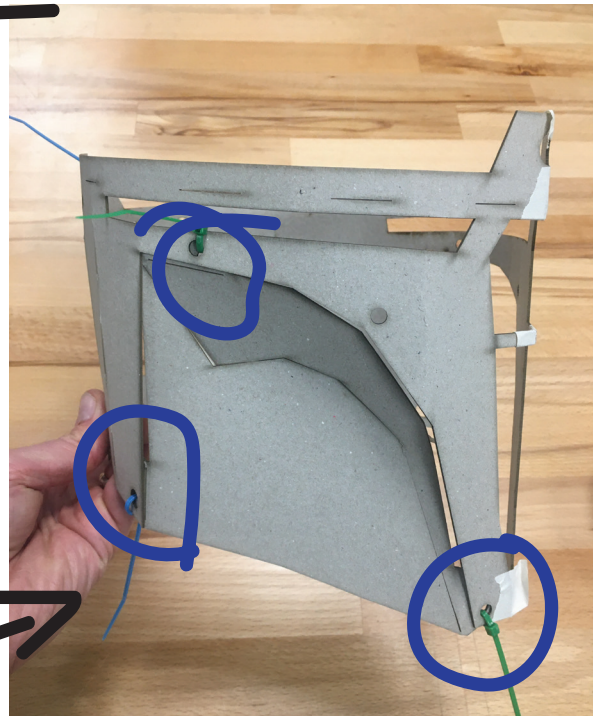
Once you have the size right, cable tie thru the 2 straps on the back of the head



STEP 4.



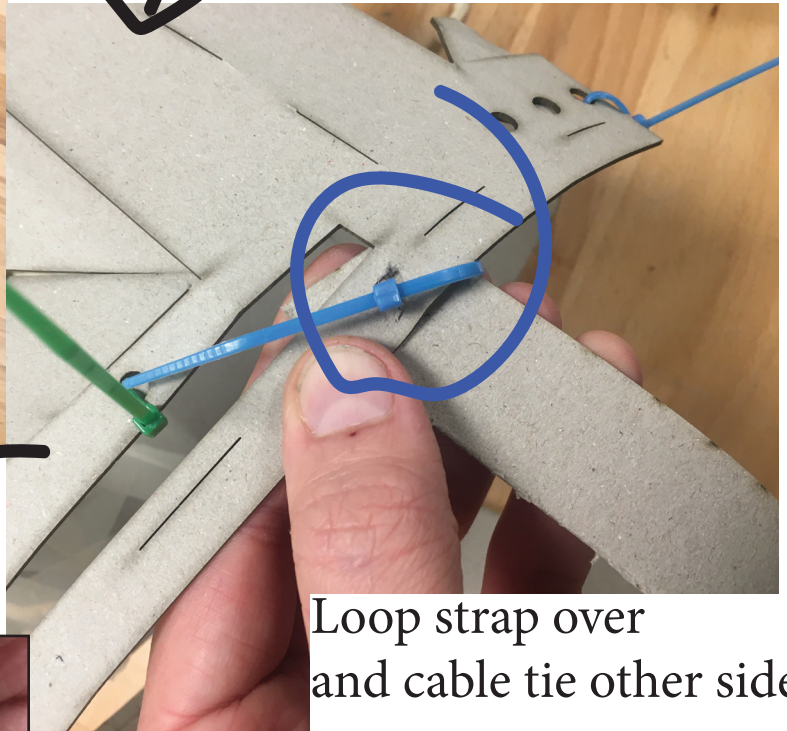
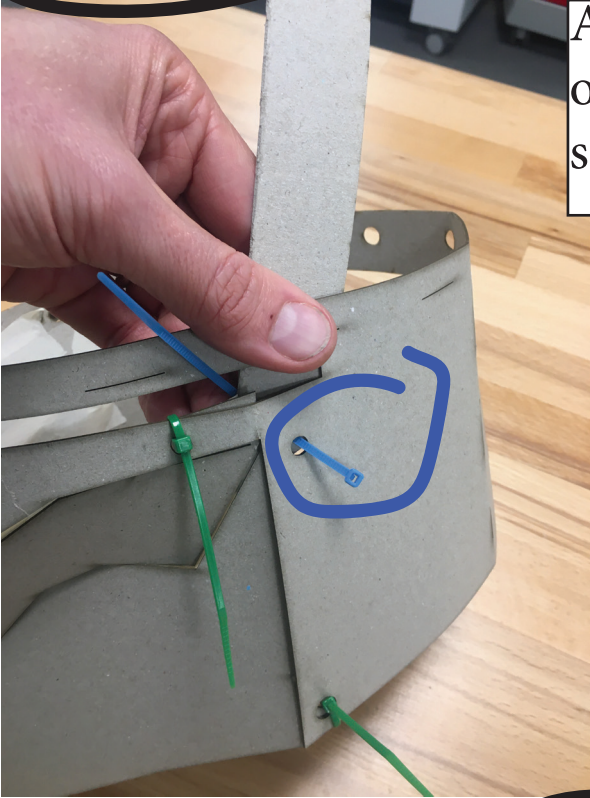
Place the cheekplates, folding tabs inside mask. Line up holes in mask with tabs.



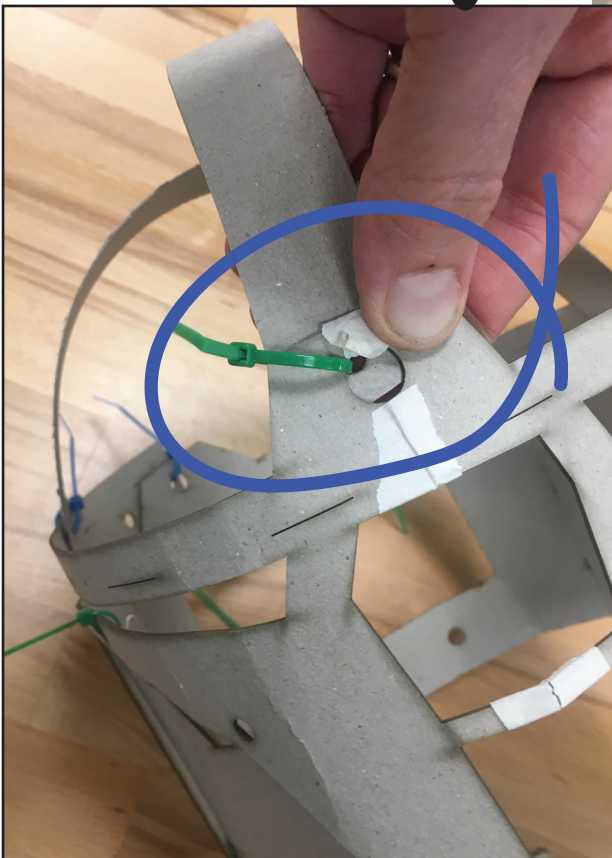
Use cable ties to attach. Repeat on other side

STEP 5.

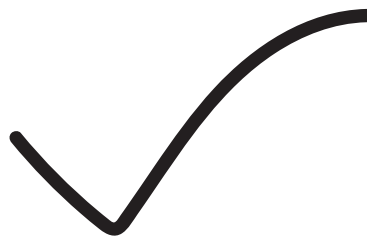
Attach head straps thru holes on side of helmet, cable tie each side



Loop strap over and cable tie other side

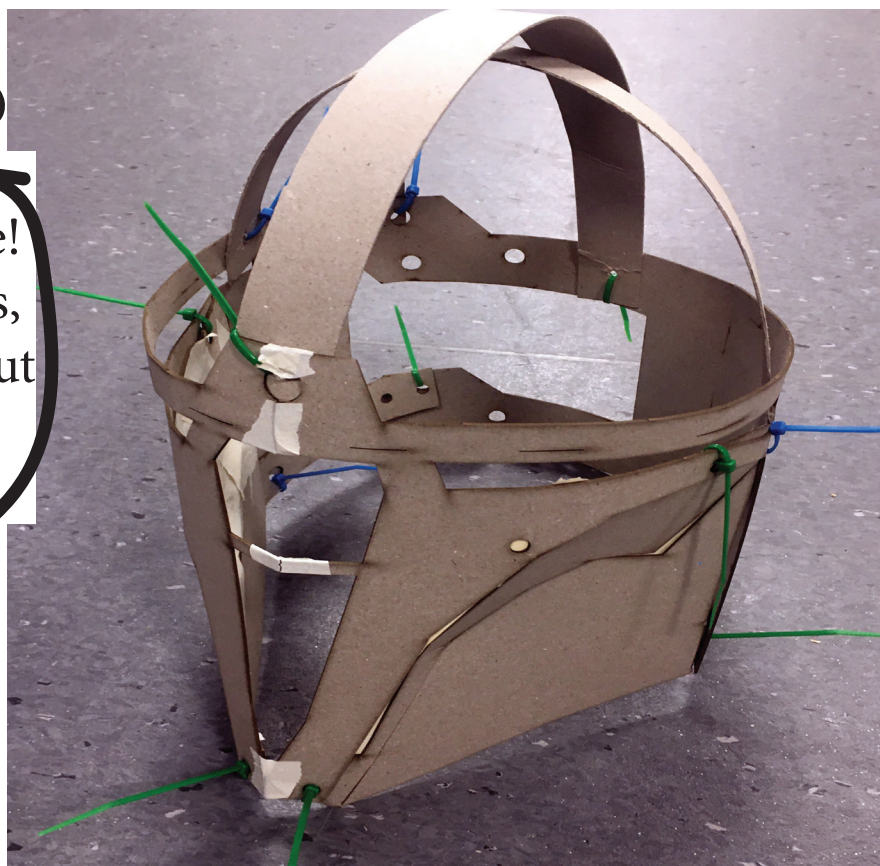


Repeat for front, attach strap on front and back of helmet. Cable tie on both ends.



STEP 6.

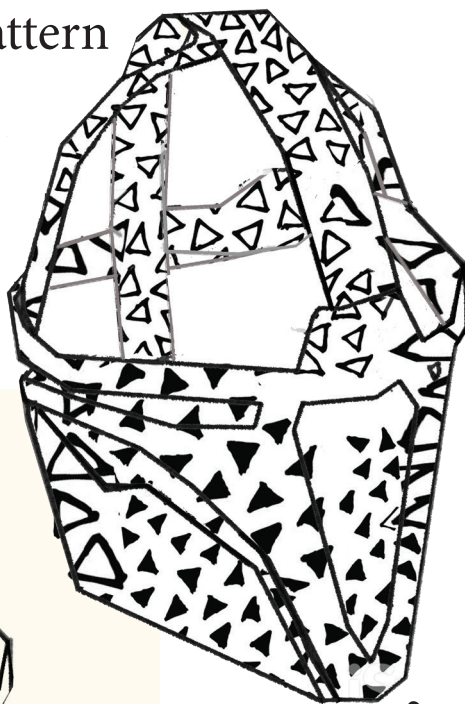
All done! Now to decorate!
You can trim the cable ties, but make sure you don't cut yourself by accident.
