- Any existing habitats should be retained for biodiversity value






The existing building infrastructure is a dominant feature of this area. Green spaces are much appreciated by the community.

## **COMMUNITY**

- Increase flexible meeting and activity outdoor spaces due to increase in demographics. 235% increase in 5-9 yrs, 259% increase in 40-44 yrs and 188% increase in 10-14 yrs (2011-2031)
- Sport spaces outdoor fitness, table tennis, water sports, no court facilities
- Limited park size and diversity of recreation opportunities
- Commonly spoken languages other than English are Korean, Mandarin, Cantonese and Hindi






The fitness station is a popular facility in the Rhodes area. Due to lockdown measures. this space is valued for community togetherness, health and wellbeing.

- Community highly values foreshore parks and walkways
- Value of the space for variety of use health, recreation, activty
- Breeze and shade make for a delightful venue
- Community members want public art incorporated into foreshore areas, including contemporary art that reflect local context
- Opportunity to increase the vibrancy of streets with markets even at night
