- THAT Council give in-principle support to installing a pedestrian crossing on Barnstaple Rd for the school children and broader community and commence the necessary investigations to be brought back to the first traffic committee meeting in the new term.
- THAT Council investigate a traffic refuge or appropriate safety measure on Brent St and bring the report back to Council.
- THAT Council write to TforNSW to seek additional school zone status including signage, road markings and signals.
- THAT Council officers provide other speed amelioration signs or other safety measures to the school community in the surrounding streets as soon as practicable e.g. Smiley Face speed monitoring signs on Brent or Barnstaple Road.
- THAT Council contact the Principal and P & C during caretaker mode to discuss the process and timing of these measures.
