Background

The Rhodes Peninsula Place Plan was adopted by Council on 11 December 2012 following over 12 months of extensive community and stakeholder consultation.

This Plan was designed as a living document to support the changing needs of the community, to help guide strategies and inform planning in relation to the delivery of recreational opportunities and open space, cultural planning and public art, local economic development, place activation and events, community development initiatives, and Rhodes communication and engagement. This Plan also set out the principles for achieving the community aspirations, involving a partnership approach between government, community, non-government, and commercial stakeholders.

The 2012 Rhodes Peninsula Place Plan contributed towards building a strong sense of community within the Rhodes peninsula – as a place to live, work and enjoy. It worked toward making the Rhodes peninsula a healthy and vibrant place as it continues to grow and evolve.
