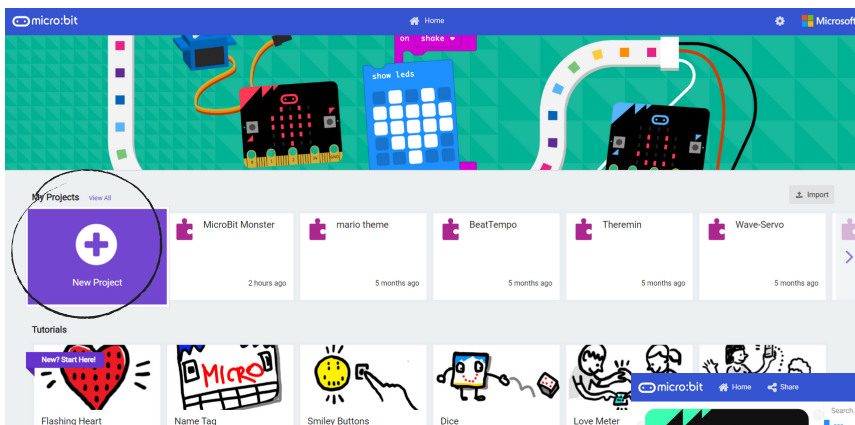
## Micro:Bit basics

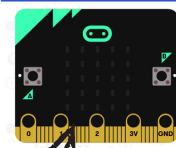

This is your virtual Micro:Bit. Your code will automatically run on it so you can use it to test your code.

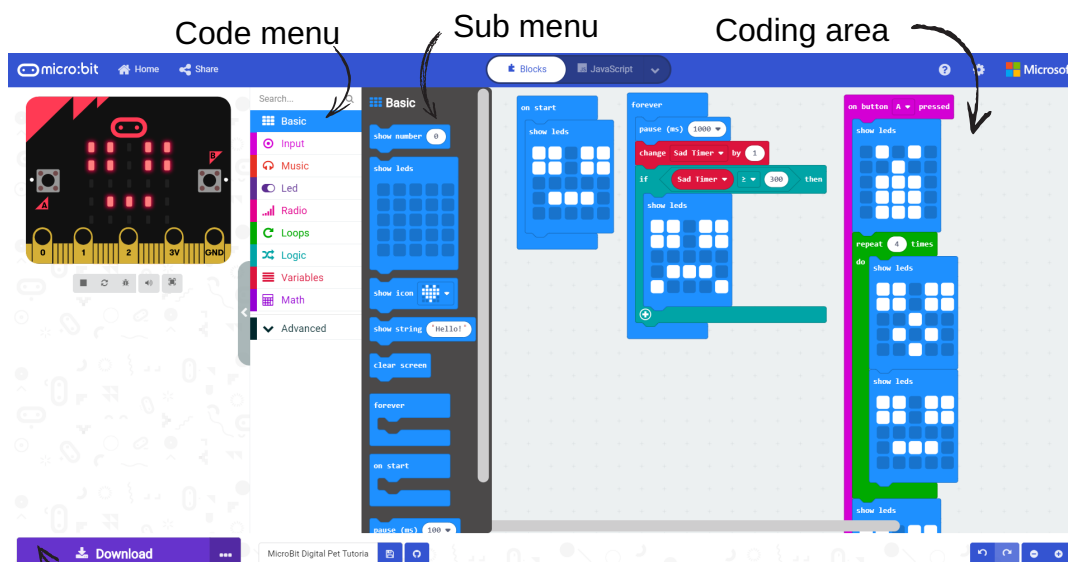
If your code has an input (like a button press), you'll need to push it on the virtual Micro:Bit.



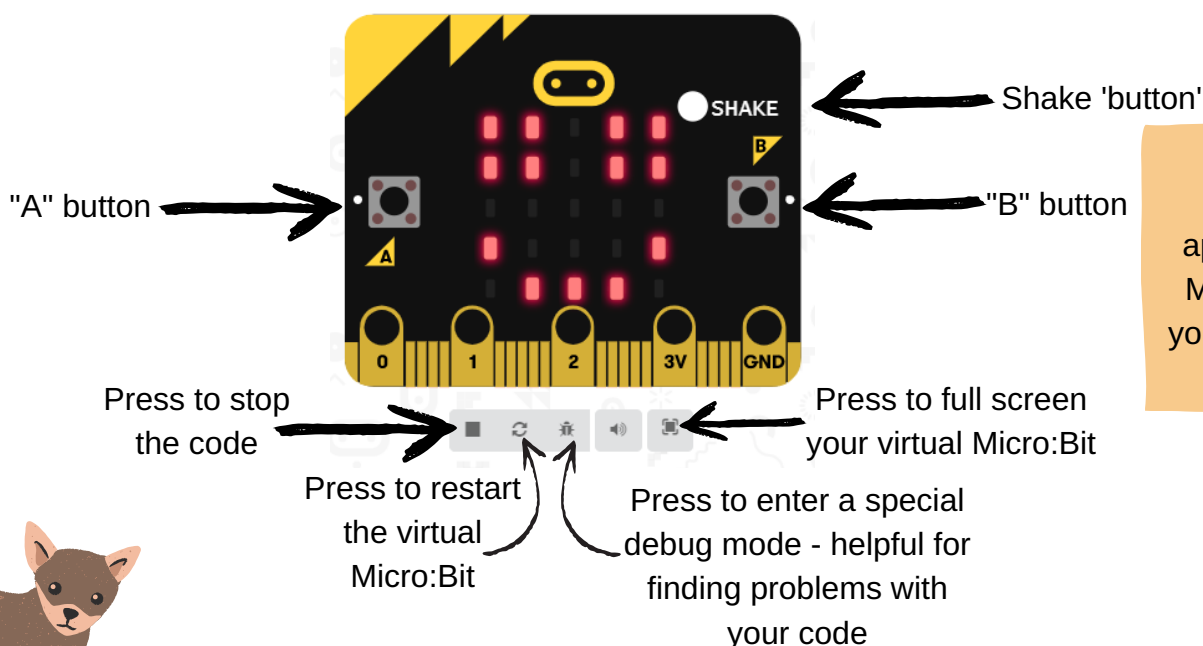
