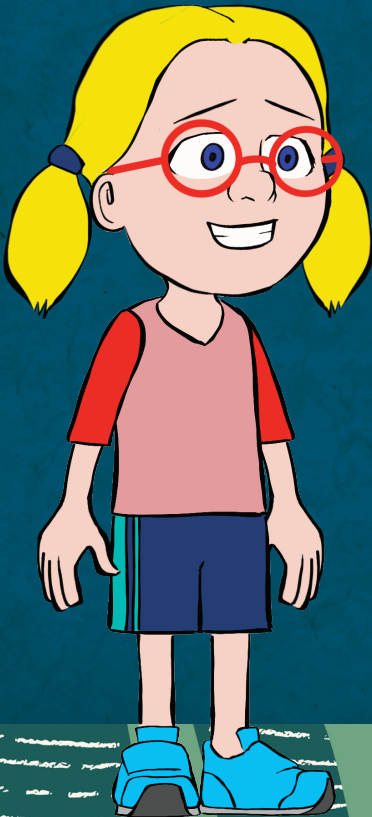
# BIODIVERSITY

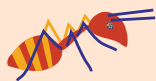

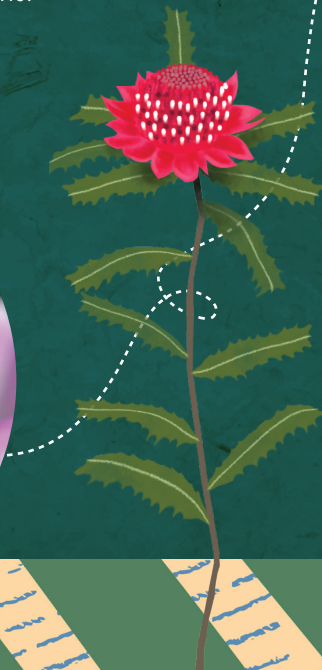


# DISCOVERING
